1. Before applying, be ready with soft copy of your **recent passport size photo**
2. Before applying, **Scan** all your Documents & your signature. **SAVE**.
3. Be ready with a **Valid mobile number** and **email-ID** to which SMS alert and every correspondence can be done.
4. Read instructions in this page properly and find the link.
5. Start filling up an online Application Form (**when link is available**).
6. Click the **“Save & Continue”** option for verifying the filled-up Form shown.
7. Print the filled-up application form and preserve it. (Do Not send it to the college now).

### Eligibility Criteria

At least **50% marks** either in Graduation or Master Degree **OR** At least **55% marks** in **B.E. / B. Tech.** with specialization in Science and Mathematics **OR**, Other qualification equivalent thereto.  
(Relaxation of 5% marks for SC/ST/PWD)

(As per NCTE regulation, 2014 and Rules of The WBUTTEPA and Department of Higher Education, Government of W.B.)

### Calculation of % of Marks

If % of marks/CGPA-Equivalent % of marks is not found on MarkSheet, then it is to be calculated using CGPA to % conversion Rule (uploaded or printed in MarkSheet) (May it be  $CGPA \times 10$ ,  $CGPA \times 10 - 5$  or other rule) or It will be calculated using  $CGPA \times 9.5$  or Weighted % calculated from Marks Obtained.

# PWD (Persons with Disability) having < 40% disability will be treated as General candidate.  
 ## SC/ST /OBC-A/OBC-B candidates residing outside of West Bengal will be treated as General.



### Academic Qualification Details (On the date of Application)

1. For H.S. (under WBCHE or CBSE class XII or ISC Class XII or equivalent level), % of marks of the best five subjects are required to enter (inclusion of **two subjects from language group is mandatory** but the marks of Environment Science/Studies Should not be calculated).
2. Honours Graduates have to enter the % of Honours marks in the row of 'Honours Degree' **BUT** Pass/General Graduates have to enter the % of total marks in the 'B.A/B.Sc./Pass/General' row only.
3. Honours Graduates having < 50% in Honours but **>=50% in (Hons. + Pass/General)** will be considered as **Pass/General** (5% relaxation for SC/ST/PWD) and have to enter the % of marks in 'Pass/General' row only.
4. Master degree holders having < 50% in Honours but **>= 50% in Master Degree** are also eligible (5% relaxation for SC/ST/PWD) and they should enter the % of Honours marks in the row of 'Honours Degree'
5. Candidates having **Integrated Master Degree** should enter % of Marks of first three years in the row of 'Honours Degree' and last two years in the row of 'Master Degree'.
6. Candidates having Masters degree in **Music** but **Honours in other subject** should enter % of Marks in Honours and Masters degree row.
7. Honours or Master Degree candidates who have not studied subjects offered by the college at Honours or Master Degree but studied it at Pass/General (see the List of offered Subjects) may apply as Pass/General. **They should not enter % of marks in the 'Honours' or 'Master's Degree' row.**
8. B.E./B.Tech. (or any other qualification equivalent thereto) candidates with Science and/or Mathematics, with 55% marks, have to enter the % of marks of B.E./ B.Tech. in the row of Honours Degree. (5% relaxation for SC/ST/PWD) and **should not enter % of marks of M.E./M.Tech. (if any) in the 'Master's Degree' row.**

### Selection Method:

1. Applications will be verified by college from uploaded documents.
2. Selection of Deputed candidates for admission will be made on Service Seniority.
3. Selection of Fresher candidates will be made on Academic Scoring.  
Score=(% of Madhyamik) x 0.1+(% of HS) x 0.2+(% of Honours/B.E./B.Tech.)x 0.3  
+ (% of Master Degree) x 0.35 +(3 for M.Phil. OR 5 for Ph.D.) (Maximum 5)
4. The Candidates who will be considered as Pass/General,  
Score=(% of Madhyamik) x 0.1+(% of HS) x 0.2+(% of Pass or General ) x 0.1  
+(% of Master Degree ) x 0.35 + (3 for M.Phil. OR 5 for Ph.D.) (Maximum 5)
5. Seat-Matrix-wise Merit lists (5 against each seat) will be published at [www.banipurbedcollege.org](http://www.banipurbedcollege.org) by 17<sup>th</sup> September 2024 Midnight.
6. **Merit-Listed candidates have to report physically with ID proof and all original hard copies of testimonials on 25<sup>th</sup> September 2024 sharp before 11:30 a.m. at college campus.**  
(In case of Online Original Documents, authentication of hard copies by the concerned authority is required.)  
After counselling, they will be permitted to pay admission fees **online** through portal and admitted.  
After admission, waiting lists will be prepared among appeared waiting candidates.
7. For Vacancy against cancellation, waiting lists will be used. Next Merit List(s) may be published if necessary.
8. **If any anomalies are detected even after admission, the candidate's admission may be cancelled.**
